2) Video Testimonial – SRT Farmer Mr. Vilas Mahalle (Amravati)

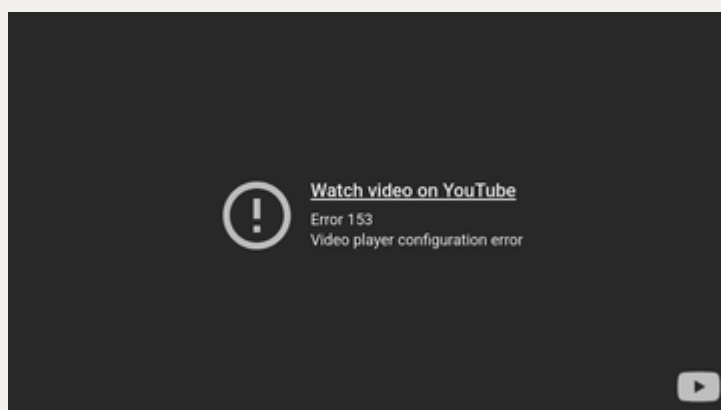
We are proud to share a powerful video testimonial by SRT farmer Mr. Vilas Mahalle from Amravati.
